USA Trade Online Database Walkthrough

The USA Trade Online Database is a very useful tool for both exporters and importers. It allows one to generate comprehensive, customized reports on the types and amounts of goods that flow between the United States and other countries, including Pakistan. It is free and easy to use.

Step 1: Create your free account

Step 2: Sign in with your new username and password

Step 3: To access Pakistan specific data, under **Harmonized System (HS) District-level Data**, select “Imports” (*Imports in this case refers to exports from Pakistan*)

Step 4: A new screen will appear. On the left hand side, under the “Report Contents” bar, select “Country”

Step 5: Adjacent to the “World Total” column, click the red “X” button to de-select all countries

Step 6: After all countries have been de-selected, scroll down the list and check only the box next to Pakistan

Step 7: On the left hand sidebar, click on “Commodity”

Step 8: Select the commodities or products by Tariff Code, of which you wish to see their data (This requires some previous knowledge of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule, see other link)

Step 9: Near the top of the page, you will see a series of options as shown here, “[USA Trade Home](#) --> [Data Source Selection](#) --> **Report Contents** --> [Report](#)”

Step 10: Simply select “Report” and information depicting Exports from Pakistan will be displayed in the given commodity which you have chosen.
