

Thank you for warmly welcoming me on my first visit to Pakistan. It was a pleasure meeting with you, and an honor to receive the Hilal-e-Pakistan.

I commend your ongoing, high-level commitment to protecting the health and well-being of every child in Pakistan, including the work to secure a polio-free future for generations of children to come.

Pakistan has made remarkable progress in the fight against wild poliovirus, with no cases for over a year—although circulation of the disease has persisted in southern Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. Your continued engagement on polio will go a long way to accelerating your country's continue progress.

I'm also glad we had the opportunity to discuss other challenges of vital importance, particularly tackling stunting and malnutrition, access to family planning services and commodities, and effective targeting of social protection programs such as Ehsaas.

Mr. President, I look forward to a deepening partnership between the Government of Pakistan and our foundation to tackle these and other issues of shared interest. I hope we can speak again soon.
