

OVERVIEW

Heavy rains and flooding swept many parts of the country this monsoon season. Sindh has been the most affected of all provinces. Notably, nearly 88 per cent of all damaged or destroyed houses – nearly 1.54 million houses – are in Sindh, and the province has also recorded the highest number of human casualties.

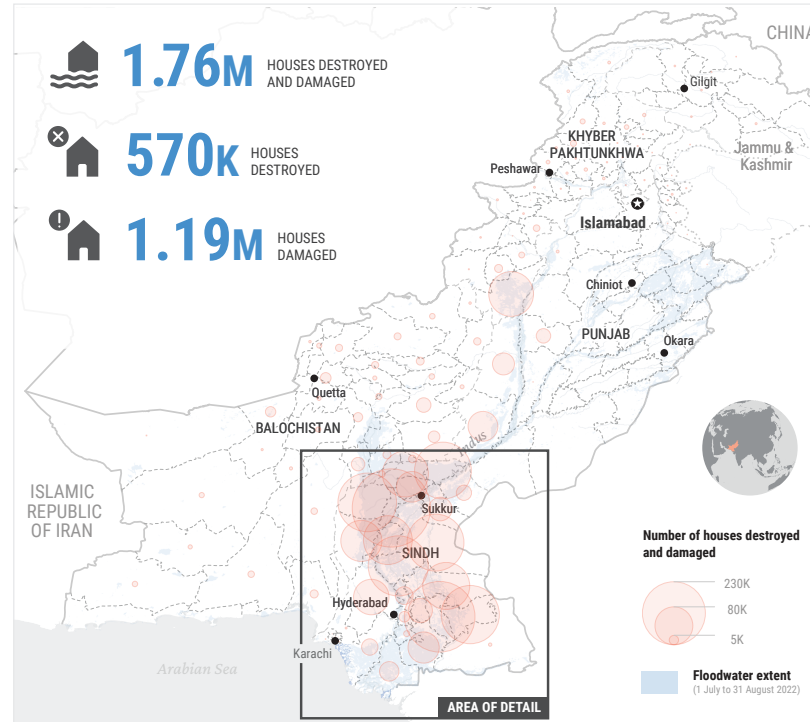

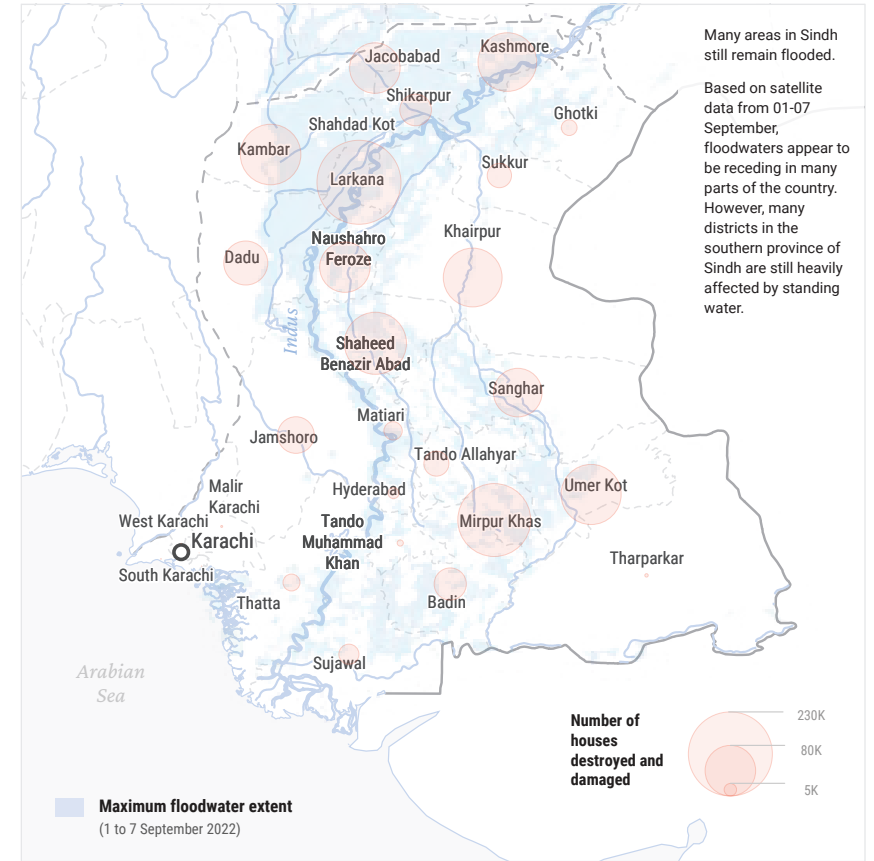
